



Purpose

The observation capture is a work-based assessment tool which assesses **skill development**, **tracks progress** and provides **targeted feedback** for improvement.



Pain point

Work-based assessments feel like 'tick-box' tasks, not meaningful learning opportunities

Manual processes make completion time-consuming and inefficient

Trainees and supervisors find them **less helpful for development** and engagement



Solution

Observation captures link directly to learning goals, providing evidence of skill development

The form is **completed online**, making the process easier and more consistent

Trainees receive **timely, constructive feedback** on real work tasks and this can
be from a range of assessors



Benefits

- Immediate, constructive feedback: from a variety of assessors offering different perspectives
- Assess a wide range of competencies: the learning goals capture a variety of professional behaviours, knowledge and skills relevant to physician practice
- Realistic evaluation of skills: based on actual, observed-tasks in the workplace



What this means in practice

- Trainees will continue to be observed and assessed in their daily work
- Trainees will have the opportunity to get feedback on their performance from their other non-physician colleagues
- The observation capture form allows assessors to specify which learning goal components were observed
