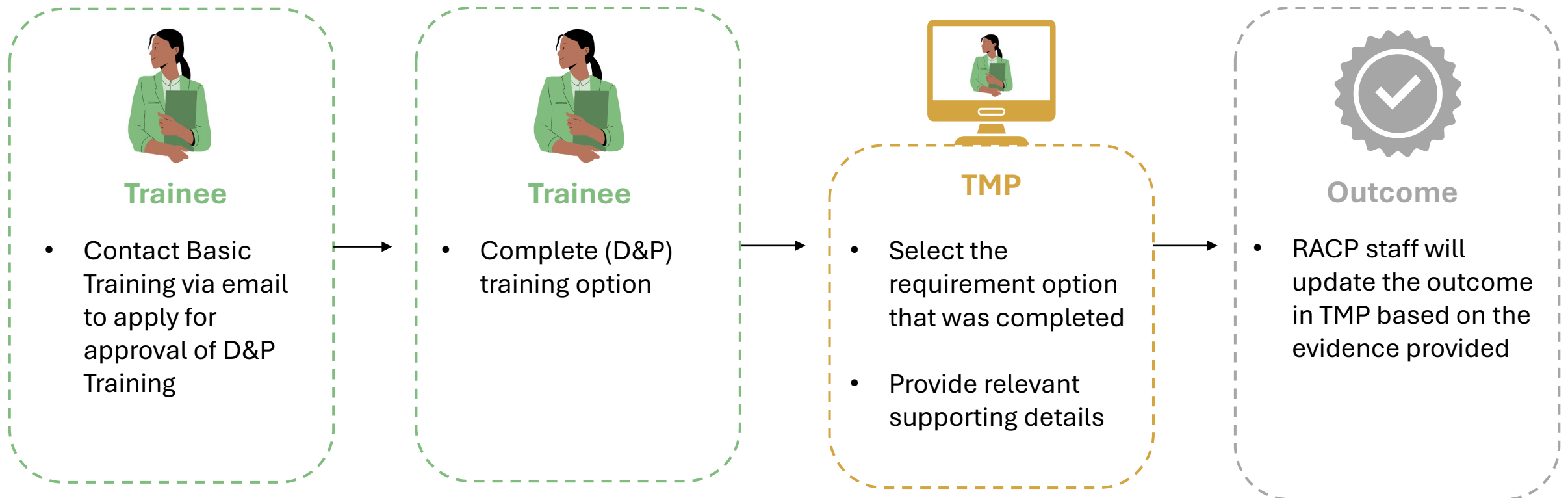


Developmental & psychosocial training

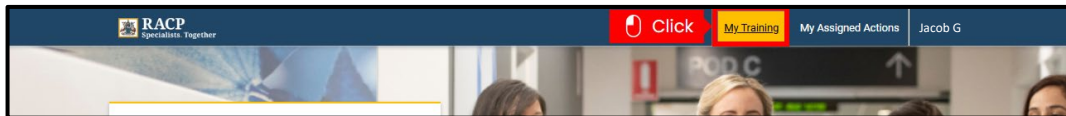

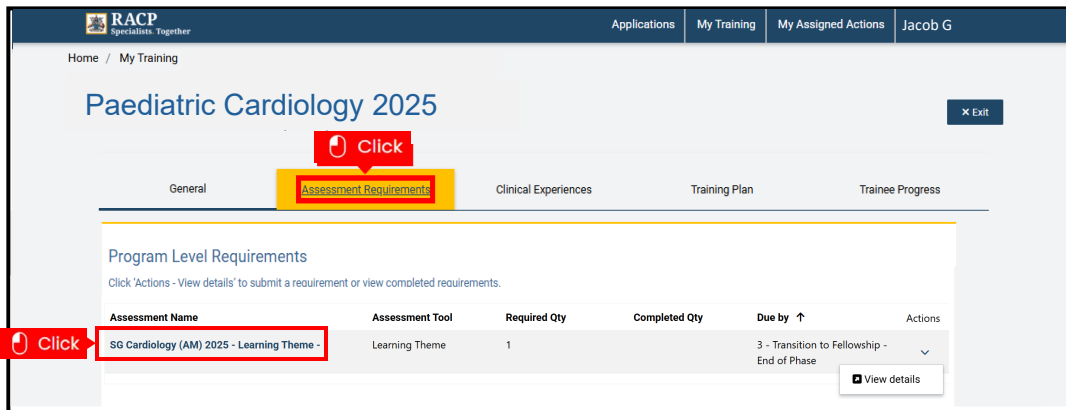

Navigate to the page

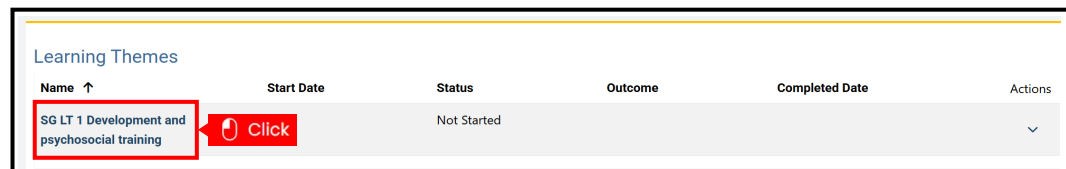
1. Sign in to TMP.

6. Select Learning Theme

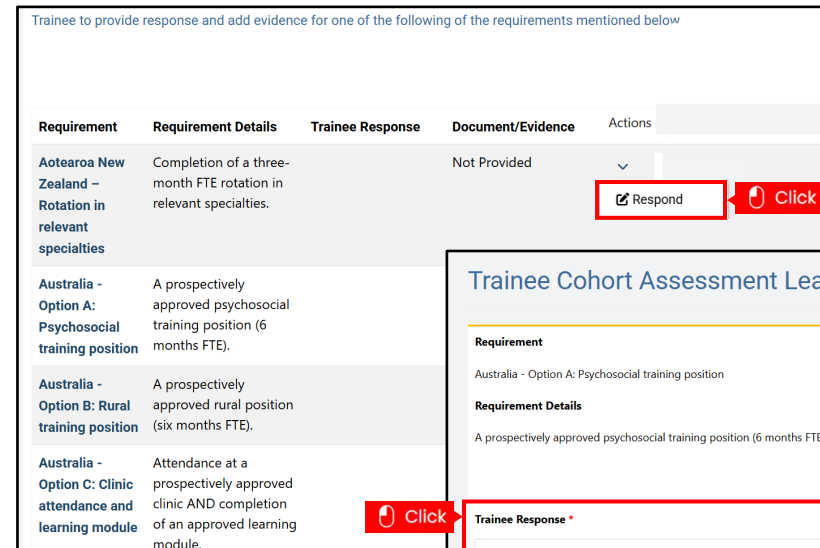


7. Select Developmental and psychosocial training from the list of learning themes

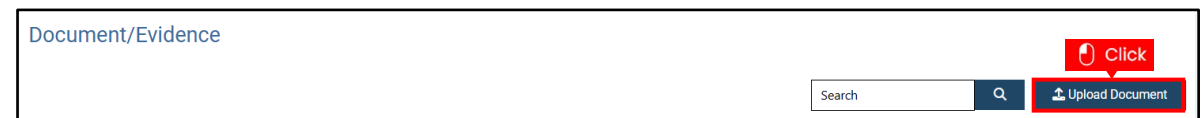
