Summary of Activity *

Aisha conducted an assessment and planning session for a patient presenting with severe benzodiazepine dependence, complicated by uncertain intake due to online sourcing. She completed a comprehensive substance use history and physical assessment, evaluated withdrawal severity, and collaborated with the inpatient team to establish a safe management plan involving inpatient stabilisation and a community-based taper.

Trainee Reflection

What did you do well?

I systematically gathered a comprehensive substance use history, assessed the patient's physical and cognitive state, and evaluated the level of withdrawal and tolerance. Despite incomplete information, I developed a safe management plan that balanced inpatient and outpatient care. I worked closely with the nursing team and discussed the plan with the patient to ensure understanding and agreement.

What could you improve next time?

The patient was tangential and difficult to assess. In future, I'll use more structured questioning to stay focused and seek corroborative information earlier. I'll also ensure I summarise key points during the assessment to confirm shared understanding and improve clarity.

How much supervision did the trainee require during this activity? *

4 – I needed to be available to contact just in case (supervision at a distance). I directly observed Aisha during the consult, and later when she was sorting out documentation for the other staff, and handover to the NUM.

What did the trainee do well? *

Aisha approached the patient professionally. She systematically assessed the patient and came up with a reasonable plan for both IP and OP management. She negotiated this with the patient well and respectfully.

What could the trainee improve upon to improve their performance? *

Her reliance on open ended questions early on in the assessment, while often a good approach, in this instance where there was some cognitive blunting, resulted in some interesting tangential revelations, but these did not help the clinical assessment much.

These are tricky patients, with quite a few unknowns on presentation which only resolve once they are observed over the initial 24 to 36 hours.

She will need to factor in the unknown variables and ensure there are contingency plans for different trajectories.
