### Summary of Activity \*

Observed and actively participated in the assessment and management of a patient presenting with acute ischemic stroke. The activity involved performing a focused neurological examination, interpreting CT imaging, discussing thrombolysis eligibility and contributing to planning for transition to rehabilitation. I also engaged in a multidisciplinary meeting with physiotherapy, occupational therapy and speech pathology teams to align goals for recovery and discharge planning.

## Trainee Reflection

### What did you do well? \*

I performed a structured neurological examination and presented my findings clearly to the team. I contributed to decision-making regarding thrombolysis eligibility and demonstrated understanding of secondary preventing strategies, including antiplatelet therapy and blood pressure control. I also engaged effectively with allied health professionals during the multidisciplinary meeting, ensuring rehabilitation goals were aligned with the patient's clinical status.

### What could you improve next time? \*

I could improve by providing a more comprehensive and structured handover to the rehabilitation team, including functional assessments and anticipated discharge needs. Additionally, I need to initiate earlier discussions with the patient and family about prognosis and goals of care to ensure expectations are managed and plans are patient-centred. Developing a checklist for transitions in care would help me standardize this process and avoid omissions.

### How much supervision did the trainee require during this activity?

### What did the trainee do well? \*

Ronnie demonstrated strong clinical reasoning and applied evidence-based guidelines for acute stroke management. Your communication with the multidisciplinary team was clear and collaborative, and you showed initiative in planning for rehabilitation. You were proactive in identifying secondary prevention priorities and demonstrated confidence in presenting your findings during the ward round.

### What could the trainee improve upon to improve their performance? \*

Consider developing a structured approach for discharge planning and patient/family discussions to ensure all aspects of care transition are addressed. Continue refining your ability to anticipate rehabilitation needs early in the admission and incorporate functional assessments into your handover. Over time, aim to take a more leadership-oriented role in coordinating multidisciplinary input and guiding junior colleagues through the process.
