Summary of Activity *

During a scheduled neurology follow-up clinic, the trainee managed the ongoing care of a 9-year-old child with Duchenne muscular dystrophy. This involved reviewing the child's functional status, respiratory and cardiac monitoring results, and assessing the impact of disease progression on daily activities. I coordinated input from physiotherapy, respiratory medicine, and social work, ensuring all recommendations were integrated into a unified care plan. I led a discussion with the family about anticipatory guidance, including future interventions, transition planning to adolescent services, and available community resources. I documented the care plan in the electronic medical record and communicated updates to the multidisciplinary team.

What did you do well? *

I successfully facilitated a comprehensive review of the child's clinical status and ensured that all relevant specialties contributed to the care plan. I engaged the family in a collaborative discussion, explaining disease progression and future planning in clear empathetic language. I also demonstrated strong organisational skills by summarising multidisciplinary recommendations and documenting them accurately for continuity of care.

What could you improve next time? *

Next time, I could improve by providing written educational materials to the family to reinforce verbal explanations. I also need to incorporate structured transition planning earlier in the process, including timelines and specific goals for adolescent care. Additionally, I could enhance my approach by using teach-back techniques to confirm family understanding and by proactively scheduling follow-up appointments with allied health professionals.

What did the trainee do well? *

Gabriel demonstrated excellent communication skills and a clear understanding of the principles of longitudinal care. Gabriel coordinated multidisciplinary input effectively and engaged the family in shared decision-making. Their documentation was thorough and reflected a proactive approach to anticipatory guidance and continuity of care.

What could the trainee improve upon to improve their performance? *

Gabriel could strengthen their performance by formalising transition planning using structured templates and ensuring these plans are shared with all stakeholders. Incorporating written resources for families and confirming understanding through teach-back methods would further enhance the quality of care. Additionally, consider developing a checklist for multidisciplinary follow-up to ensure no aspect of care is overlooked.
