## Learning Capture Details

### Description of Activity \*

I participated in a population health project reviewing local developmental and health screening coverage rates using population health data. Under the supervision of a consultant paediatrician and public health academic, I analysed trends by postcode and identified areas of low coverage associated with socioeconomic disadvantage. I presented the findings at the weekly population health meeting and contributed recommendations for targeted outreach clinics and culturally appropriate communication strategies for families with limited healthcare access.

### What did you learn? \*

I gained practical experience in interpreting population health data, identifying health inequities and linking epidemiological findings to service planning. I learned how to communicate data-driven recommendations to clinicians and public health experts, translating evidence into actionable strategies. This activity deepened my understanding of how community-level interventions complement individual clinical care and the importance of advocacy in improving child health outcomes.

### How will you apply this learning in the future? \*

I will apply these skills in future rotations by integrating a focus on equity and knowledge of the determinants of health into my clinical decision-making. This experience has encouraged me to consider how clinical practice can influence broader health policy and child wellbeing.
