## Learning Capture Details

### Description of Activity \*

As part of the community child health rotation, I participated in a school-entry health assessment clinic, screening children aged 4-5 years for growth, vision, hearing, and developmental milestones. I conducted assessments under supervision, identified children with delayed development, and initiated referrals to allied health, primary care, and specialist services.

I collaborated with school nurses and public health staff to review screening data, discuss barriers to attendance and identify vulnerable populations requiring follow-up.

### What did you learn? \*

I learned how population-based screening can identify developmental and health needs early, particularly in children from socioeconomically disadvantaged backgrounds. I developed skills in interpreting screening outcomes, applying referral pathways and understanding the role of multidisciplinary coordination in community paediatrics.

I also gained insight into the population health significance of early intervention and the link between screening participation and educational outcomes.

### How will you apply this learning in the future? \*

I will integrate population-based assessment principles into my future clinical work by recognising community-level trends and addressing systemic barriers to access. I plan to collaborate closely with schools and primary care providers to ensure that at-risk children receive timely interventions.
